## **Published admission number (PAN)**

The published admissions number for entry to the academy in year 7 is 210 students. Sixth form: 210 (of which year 12 is 110). The external PAN for year 12 is 30. If fewer than 110 of the academy's own year 11 pupils transfer into year 12, additional external pupils will be admitted until year 12 reaches its capacity of 110.
