

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FLINTHAM FOOTPATH NO.2) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Flintham Footpath No.2) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2023 (which came into force on 19th December 2023 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which remains in force until 18th June 2024 inclusive and was further continued in force by a Continuation No.2 Order which remains in force until 18th December 2024 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 18th December 2025 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Flintham in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

<u>Flintham Footpath No.2</u> from the sewage works to the junction with Flintham Byway No.9 Longhedge Lane.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows:-

Main Street Flintham and Footpath No.3 to join Longhedge Lane and vice versa.

If the works are not completed within the above period the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to flood damaged bridge, and to enable its replacement.
