

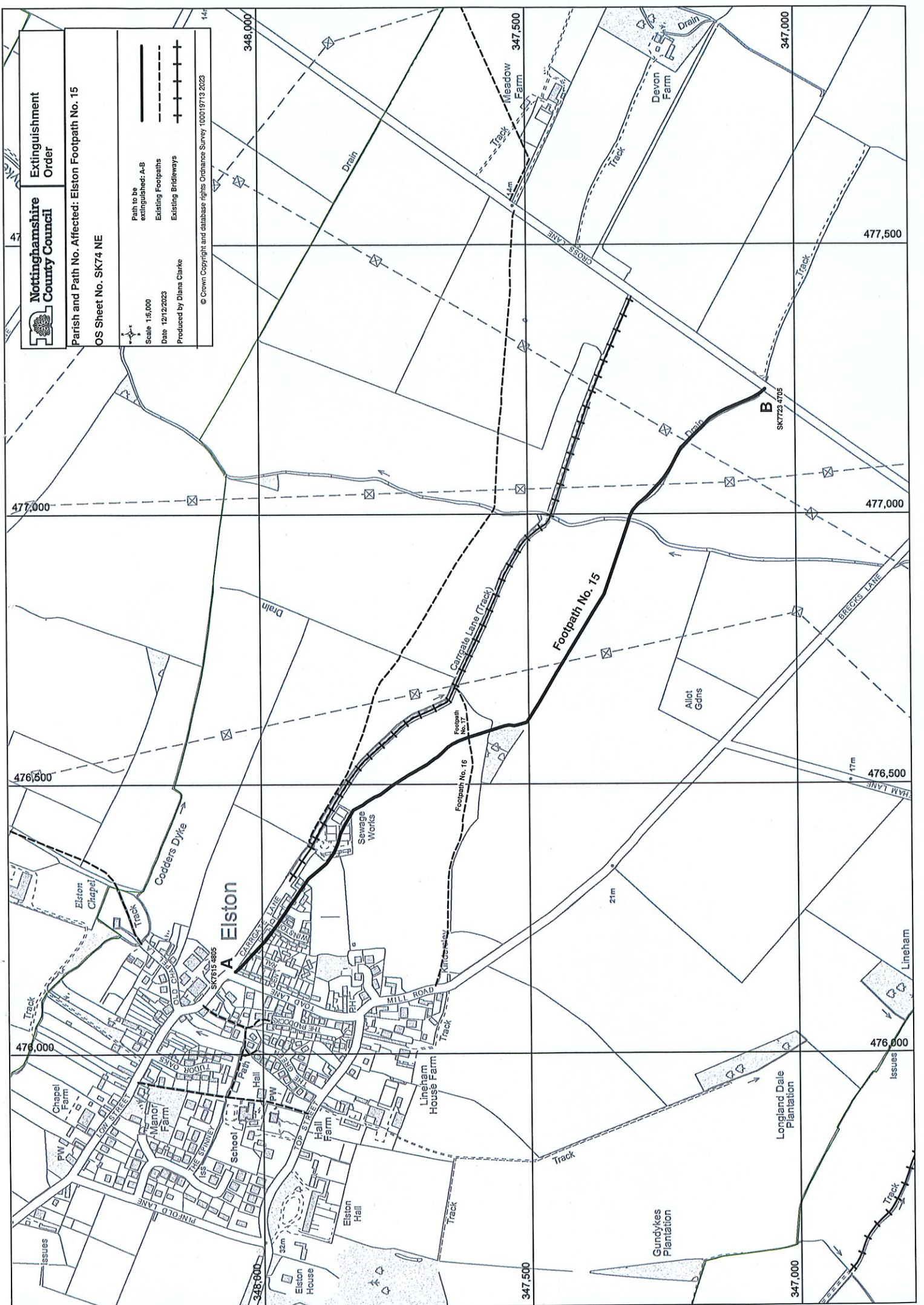


Parish and Path No. Affected: Elston Footpath No. 15

### Description of Public Right of Way Extinguished

The whole width of the footpath commencing from point A, (SK7615 4805), at the junction of Carrgate Lane and Toad Lane and proceeding for a distance of 1520 metres in a generally south easterly direction through a housing development then a sewage farm then across fields to point B, (SK7723 4705), at the junction with Cross Lane.
