Published Admission Number (PAN)

The published admission number for entry to the academy in year 7 is 180.

Sixth form: 250 (of which year 12 is 125). The external PAN for year 12 is 5. If fewer than 120 of the academy's own year 11 students transfer into year 12, additional external students will be admitted until year 12 meets its capacity of 125.

Supplementary application form

The supplementary admissions form is for applicants who wish church commitment to be taken into consideration as part of their application. This form, which can be found on the academy's website must be completed in addition to the local authority's application form

Oversubscription criteria – year 7

	Measurement of attendance
	In the event that during the period specified for attendance at worship the church
	has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for
	that worship, the requirements of these admissions arrangements in relation to
	attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises
	have been available for public worship.
	Applicants must complete the supplementary information form which can be
	obtained from the academy.
