Why? Protects you and your baby

When? Any time in pregnancy, every pregnancy - but only during autumn/winter

Where? Maternity hospital, GP or Pharmacy

COVID-19

Why? Protects you and your baby

When? Any time in pregnancy, every pregnancy- but only during autumn/winter

Where? GP or Pharmacy

**WHOOPIING
COUGH**

Why? Protects your baby until they are old enough to be vaccinated at 8 weeks old

When? From 16 weeks of pregnancy in every pregnancy

Where? Maternity hospital (usually at 20-week scan) or GP

RSV

Why? Protects your baby when they're born

When? From 28 weeks of pregnancy in every pregnancy

Where? Maternity hospital or GP
