
REASON: To facilitate public safety during installation

When Pasture Lane meets Meadow Lane take the un-numbered footpath in front of you. Travel northeast on the un-numbered footpath to meet footpath No.7. Travel northwest on footpath No.7 to meet the disused railway line. Travel northeast along the disused line. When you reach Barton Lane turn right and this will join Beeston Bridleway No.70. This Bridleway will re-join the Trent Valley Way on the Nottingham side of the closure. Vice Versa from the North.

Access will be maintained, whenever reasonably possible, on the affected length of footpath. The footpath will re-open as soon as the work is finished. This may be earlier than advertised. The County Council has made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to prohibit its use by traffic.
