# THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CARLTON RESTRICTED BYWAY NO. 46 AND BRIDLEWAY NO. 47) MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Nottinghamshire (Area 3) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (c) (i) of the Act, namely the discovery of evidence that rights of way subsist or are reasonably alleged to subsist over land situated at Carlton.

The Authority have consulted with every Local Authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

The Nottinghamshire County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.
- 2. The Nottinghamshire (Area 3) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to this Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Carlton Restricted Byway No. 46 and Bridleway No. 47) Modification Order 2015".


Carlton Restricted Byway No. 46

Commencing from a point, SK 59144248, at the junction with Lees Road and proceeding for a distance of approximately 235 metres in a south-easterly then south-westerly direction to a point, SK 59114231, at the junction with Porchester Road and having a width of 207 metres throughout the whole of its length.

Jurchen with Konnzik Road and having a width of 2.7 metres between SK 5914 4248 and SK 5921 Carlton Bridleway No. 47

Commencing from a point, SK 59214243, at the junction with Carlton Restricted Byway No. 46 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 68 metres in a south-easterly direction to a point, SK 59274238, at the junction with Kenrick Road and having a width of 2.4 metres throughout the whole of its length.

Carlton Restricted Byway No. 46

Commencing from a point, SK 59144248, at the junction with Lees Road and proceeding for a distance of approximately 235 metres in a south-easterly then south-westerly direction on the metalled surfaces of Ethel Avenue and Emmanuel Avenue to a point, SK 59114231, at the junction with Porchester Road and having a width of 2.7 metres throughout the whole of its length.

its length: direction to a point, SK5921 4238 at the junction with Kennick Road, having a metalled surface and midth of 2.7 metres between SK5914 4248 and SK5921

Commencing from a point, SK 59214243, at the junction with Carlton Restricted Byway No. 46 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 68 metres in a south-easterly direction on an earth and grass surface between property boundaries to a point, SK 59274238, at the junction with Kenrick Road and having a width of 2.4 metres throughout the whole of its length.
