MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by the Nottinghamshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to that Authority that the Nottinghamshire (Area 7) Definitive Map requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section (53)(3)(b) of the Act, namely the expiration of a period such that the enjoyment by the public of the ways during the period raises the presumption that the ways have been dedicated as public footpaths over land at Bilsthorpe.

The Authority have consulted with every Local Authority whose area includes land to which the Order relates.

The Nottinghamshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 July 2024.
2. The Nottinghamshire (Area 7) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as “The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bilsthorpe Footpath No.19 and Footpath No. 20) Modification Order 2024”.

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of the Path or Way to be added

Bilsthorpe Footpath No. 19

Commencing from a point, SK 6508 5963 at the junction with Bilsthorpe Footpath No. 3 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 175 metres in a generally north westerly direction to a point, SK 6493 5972, and continuing for a distance of approximately 265 metres in a generally south westerly direction to a point SK 6469 5963 at the junction with Bilsthorpe Bridleway No.7.

Width: 1.5 metres between points SK 6508 5963 and SK 6469 5963.

Limitations: None

Bilsthorpe Footpath No. 20

Commencing from a point, SK 6493 5972, at the junction with Bilsthorpe Footpath No.19 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 385 metres in a generally northerly direction to a point, SK 6495 6013, at the junction with Bilsthorpe Bridleway No.7.

Width: 1.5 metres between points SK 6493 5972 and SK 6495 6013
