

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WEST LEAKE BRIDLEWAY NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council (in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) being the traffic authority for the length or lengths of highway referred to in this Notice, hereby directs, because the restriction or prohibition should come into force without delay, that: -

- (1) No person shall: (a) proceed on foot,
 - (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
 - (c) cause any horse to proceed and
 - (d) cause any animal to proceed

in the following length of bridleway at West Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

West Leake Bridleway No.1 (Wossock Lane)

between its junction with West Leake Footpath No.2 and where it passes between Crownend Wood and Leake New Wood to link up with Gotham Bridleway No.12.

- (2) <u>AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN</u> that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for **pedestrians** is West Leake BW1 to the closure point, West Leake FP2, West Leake BW5, West Leake BW3, Gotham BW10 and Gotham BW11 and vice versa.
- The alternative route for **Cyclists and Equestrians** is Dark Lane, Main Street, West Leake BW3, Gotham BW10 and Gotham BW11 and vice versa.
- (3) The Temporary Notice is required from 31st July 2024 to protect public safety due to subsidence concerns which require investigation and remedial action.

Further Notice

- (a) No prohibition, restriction or prescription contained in this Notice shall apply to any person acting in accordance with any permission or direction given by a Police Constable in uniform.
- (b) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Notice shall apply so as to make it unlawful for any vehicle to proceed in the length of highway specified in the said paragraph for the purposes of access to or egress from premises, provided that the said access or egress may only be gained by proceeding over the length of highway specified in the said paragraph, provided that the works being carried out would not be inconveniently interrupted.
- (c) Nothing in paragraph 1 of this Notice shall apply to any person proceeding in connection with works to be carried out in or in the vicinity of the length or lengths of highway specified in the said paragraph.
- (d) Nothing in Paragraph 1 of this Notice shall apply to any person proceeding in connection with the works in the length or lengths of highway specified in this Notice.
- (e) This Notice is valid for a period of 21 days from the date of this Notice. This Notice may be continued by a further 21-day Notice and/or a Continuation Order (within a maximum period of 6 months).
