

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BECKINGHAM FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Beckingham Footpath No.1) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2023 (which came into force on 1st July 2023 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order until 31st December 2023 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 31st December 2024 or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Beckingham in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Beckingham Footpath No.1 from its junction with Church Lane, for a distance of 90 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to enable approved development works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.
