



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(EAST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.21)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**EAST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.21**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2024**.

That Notice came into force on 10th May 2024.

The effects are that:-

No person shall:

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at East Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe -

East Bridgford Footpath No.21, from its junction with Holloway Close to the far side of the first field.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be along Closes Side Lane or Butt Lane.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 9th November 2024 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 31st May 2024 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety and enable approved development to take place around the footpath.
