

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WEST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.43) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>WEST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.43</u>) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE <u>2025</u>.

That Notice came into force on 21st January 2025.

The effects are that:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe-

WEST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.43, its entire length between Abbey Road and Buckfast Way, a distance of 235 metres.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route is along the footway on Abbey Road and Buckfast Way.

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 20th July 2025 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 11th February 2025 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety while development works are taking place.
