

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SUTTON IN ASHFIELD BRIDLEWAY NO.162) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (<u>SUTTON IN</u> **ASHFIELD BRIDLEWAY NO.162**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2024**.

That Notice came into force on 25th April 2024.

The effects are that: - No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed,
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following sections of Bridleway at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield-

<u>Sutton in Ashfield Bridleway No.162</u> – 2 sections – (1) Between Mansfield Road/Buttery Lane and the junction with Bridleway No. 165 and (2) between Newbound Mill Lane and the junction with Footpath No.8 and No.164 North of Dawgates Wood.

<u>AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN</u> that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for Cyclists or Equestrians other than on public roads, there are various possible alternatives with stepped access for those on foot.

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 24th October 2024 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 16th May 2024 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety due to the dangerous condition of 2 overbridges passing above the trail, and to enable the condition of these to be assessed and plans put in place for their repair.
