

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HOLME PIERREPONT FOOTPATH NO.1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**HOLME PIERREPONT FOOTPATH NO.1**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2024**.

That Notice came into force on 25th April 2024.

The effects are that: - No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Holme Pierrepont in the Borough of Rushcliffe-

Holme Pierrepont Footpath No.1, where it turns east after the first bridge from Holme Lane Byway No.12 (just west of a second bridge) to the eastern side of this second bridge.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows: -

Holme Pierrepont Byway No.12, Holme Pierrepont Byway No.13, Radcliffe Road, to the open sections of Holme Pierrepont Footpath No.1 and vice versa

<u>IT IS INTENDED</u> that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 24th October 2024 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 16th May 2024 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety while repairs are carried out to the footbridges on the footpath.
