

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GREASLEY FOOTPATH NO.51 AND NO.52)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - Proceed on foot,

in the following lengths of Footpath at Greasley in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

Greasley Footpath No.51 and No.52 between Commons Close and Bridleway No.49.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 20th June 2024 until 19th December 2024 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via Greasley Bridleway No.49.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable approved housing development, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
