



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH**

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(GRANBY FOOTPATH NO.3)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2025**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**GRANBY FOOTPATH NO.3**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2025**.

That Notice came into force on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2025.

The effects are that:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Granby in the Borough of Rushcliffe-

**Granby Footpath No.3**, from the ditch board crossing at SK 76237 36869, to its junction with Granby Footpath No.4 at SK 76499 36595.

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction the alternative route available for pedestrians will be as follows: -

Sutton Lane, Granby Footpath No.15, Granby Footpath No.14 and vice versa

**IT IS INTENDED** that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025 inclusive.

**The Continuation Order will come into force on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025** and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

**The prohibition is required** to protect public safety and enable essential repairs to be carried out to the timber footbridge and ditch board crossings on the footpath.
