



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDLEWAY

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COTGRAVE BRIDLEWAY NO.5)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

No person shall:-

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,
- (c) cause any horse to proceed and
- (d) cause any animal to proceed,

in the following length of bridleway at Cotgrave in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Cotgrave Bridleway No.5 its entire length between Colston Gate and Hollygate Lane.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 6th January 2025 until 5th July 2025 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the developer will provide an alternative non definitive route around the edge of the development.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the bridleway. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required due to enable construction of an approved housing development, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the bridleway.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
