

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GREASLEY FOOTPATH NO.26 AND KIMBERLEY FOOTPATH NO.25) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION NO.3 ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State Transport in pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 approves of The Nottinghamshire County Council (Greasley Footpath No.26 and Kimberley Footpath No.25) (Temporary Prohibition) Notice 2024 (which came into force on 24th January 2024 and was continued in force by a Continuation Order which remained in force until 23rd July 2024, and was then continued in force by a Continuation No.2 Order which remains in force until 23rd January 2025 inclusive) being extended and continuing in force until 23rd January 2026, or until completion of the relevant works, whichever is the sooner.

The Order has the following effect:-

No person shall: -

(a) proceed on foot,

in the following length of Footpath at Greasley and Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

<u>Kimberley footpath No.25 continuing as Greasley Footpath No.26</u> – for a distance of approximately 250 metres.

<u>AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN</u> that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route available for pedestrians on public rights of way.

If the works are not completed within the above period, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the further approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The prohibition is required to protect public safety and to enable works to be carried out to repair the damaged footpath surface.
