

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WEST BRIDGFORD FOOTPATH NO.12 AND NCN CYCLE ROUTE 15) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be: -

No person shall: -

- (a) proceed on foot,
- (b) cause any pedal cycle to proceed,

in the following length of Footpath and Cycle Track at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

West Bridgford Footpath No.12/ NCN Cycle Route 15

Between Lady Bay Bridge and Trent Fields, a distance of 580 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From 10th February 2025 until 28th March 2025 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction there is no alternative route other than by road.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to facilitate vegetation clearance and tree felling in close proximity to the footpath, along the southern embankment of the Trent, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED, AND IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THIS WILL ONLY BE FOR A SHORT TIME FRAME WITHIN THE DATES SHOWN.
