

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GREASLEY FOOTPATH NO.32 AND NO.40) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) CONTINUATION ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an ORDER, under Sections 14 and 15(8) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

To continue the effects of THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (**Greasley Footpath No.32 and No.40**) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) NOTICE **2024**.

That Notice came into force on 11th October 2024.

The effects are that:-

No person shall: - proceed on foot, in the following lengths of Footpath at Greasley in the Borough of Broxtowe :-

Greasley Footpath No.32, from its junction with Main Street, Newthorpe at grid reference SK 4833 4628 to its junction with Footpath No.28 at grid reference SK 4846 4647, comprising a distance of approximately 240 metres.

Greasley Footpath No.40, between its junction with Footpath No.32 at grid reference SK 4838 4635 and its junction with Footpath No.41 at grid reference SK 4829 4637, comprising a distance of approximately 90 metres.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above highway or highways will apply as follows:-

To 10th April 2025 inclusive.

The Continuation Order will come into force on 1st November 2024 and any prohibition contained in the continued Order shall apply on that day and on any subsequent day or days when it shall be necessary for the prohibition to apply to enable works to be carried out and the Order shall continue in full force until the works it is proposed to carry out are completed. The duration of this Order may be extended with the approval of the relevant Secretary of State.

The prohibition is required to enable works to be carried out over the paths, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpaths.
